
Guidance Decision – D.12-05-015 (May 2012)

- Continues and expands scope of CALCTP
- Initiates WE&T Sector Strategy efforts directed toward the problematic HVAC sector
- Reiterates Exploration of other Sector Strategy opportunities
- Ensures safety training is included in any WE&T training efforts as necessary
- Ensures efforts to include WE&T participation from low-income / under privileged populations
- Improves data collection for WE&T programs











October 8 Decision Approving 2013 – 2014 EE Programs

- IOUs to hire a consultant to develop a comprehensive WE&T approach to be launched in 2015
- IOUs required to begin data collection for workforce related metrics
- IOUs to submit detailed WE&T related budget allocations for 2013 - 2014

Initial Considerations for Scope of Work

- Integration across Demand-side Management programs
- Linkage with incentive programs and codes and standards
- Support with Sector Strategy development, standardize and integrate across the IOUs
- Identification of WE&T success metrics
- Identification of market opportunities and training gaps
- Enhancing outreach to low income and disadvantaged populations
