Dear Mr. Cherry:

By your letter dated December 28, 2012, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), on behalf of the California Solar Initiative (CSI) Program Administrators, requests an extension of time to comply with Resolution E-4534 which requires the CSI Program Administrators to jointly file a Tier 1 Advice Letter revising the CSI Program Handbook to conform to the changes of the resolution within 60 days of the issuance of resolution.¹ PG&E requests an extension of time until January 24, 2013.

Your letter states that implementation of the CSI Program Handbook changes is predicated on changes to the CSI online application database, PowerClerk. According to your letter, Clean Power Research, the third party company that manages PowerClerk, is unable to make the necessary changes by the deadlines stipulated in Resolution E-4534 because of holiday scheduling constraints.

The reasons cited in your letter justify an extension of time for the CSI Program Administrators to file a Tier 1 Advice Letter in compliance with Resolution E-4534. This report shall be due on January 24, 2013.
