In accordance with General Order 96-B, Section 5.3, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (“PG&E”) hereby withdraws Advice Letter 3340-G/4136-E without prejudice. The Advice Letter was filed on November 9, 2012, and sought the California Public Utilities Commission’s approval to revise PG&E’s California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) re-certification application form for residential single-family customers. The requested revisions would remove categorical eligibility as a means of renewal in the program in accordance with Decision 12-08-044. However, because categorical eligibility guidelines will be clarified during the second phase of the Energy Savings Assistance/CARE consolidated proceeding (PG&E’s Application 11-05-019), PG&E respectfully withdraws AL 3340-G/4136-E.
