**Subject:** Gas Incident at 195 Shawnee Street, San Francisco (3/11)

At approximately 4:00 am this morning, at 195 Shawnee Street, San Francisco, a car accident severed a PG&E riser. Gas was released as a result. The SFFD stopped the blowing gas with a redwood plug at the service (PG&E is still gathering information regarding the time this occurred). A PG&E GSR wing quock was on site at 4:38 AM. The riser was a single service riser and one customer was out of service as a result of the incident. A Channel 4 News Helicopter was seen around 5:20 AM. There were no injuries, fatalities, and no ignition. Damage is less than \$50,000. Reportable due to media on site.
