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Energy Division staff request information from Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), Southern California Edison Company (SCE) and San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) regarding electricity customers that are in industrial sectors designated as “emissions intensive and trade exposed” (EITE) by Decision (D).12-12-033.

For the purposes of this data request, EITE industries (or “EITE NAICS codes”) are those industries designated by the NAICS codes listed in Table 8-1 of the Air Resources Board’s Cap and Trade Regulation.¹

¹ See Table 8-1 in CCR Title 17, §95870, for a list of NAICS codes to evaluate.

Please provide in table form the following information in an Excel file. Utilities should report totals, not results by individual NAICS codes.

PG&E:

- 1) Total number of unique electricity service agreements associated with one of the eligible EITE NAICS codes.
- 2) Total number of unique premises that have at least one electricity service agreement associated with one of the eligible EITE NAICS codes.
- 3) Total 2012 kWh bundled energy sales to all service agreements included in part 1 above.
- 4) Total 2012 kWh direct access/CCA sales to all service agreements included in part 1 above.

“Service agreements” and “premises” refer to corresponding levels of customer information in PG&E’s billing system.

SCE:

- 1) Total number of unique electricity service accounts associated with one of the eligible EITE NAICS codes.
- 2) Total number of unique sites that have at least one electricity service account associated with one of the eligible EITE NAICS codes.
- 3) Total 2012 kWh bundled energy sales to all service accounts included in part 1 above.
- 4) Total 2012 kWh direct access/CCA sales to all service accounts included in part 1 above.

“Service accounts” and “sites” refer to corresponding levels of customer information in SCE’s billing system.

SDG&E:

- 1) Total number of unique electricity accounts associated with one of the eligible EITE NAICS codes.
- 2) Total 2012 kWh bundled energy sales to all accounts included in part 1 above.
- 3) Total 2012 kWh direct access/CCA sales to all accounts included in part 1 above.

“Accounts” refers to account level customer information as defined in SDG&E’s billing system. Each account should correspond with a unique physical premise.
