Re: Approval of Request for Proposal Scoring and Selection of a Firm Responsible for Proposing Expanded Outreach and Education Activities Related to the GHG Allowance Revenue Return for 2014 and 2015, Directed by Decision (D.) 12-12-033.

Dear Ms. Pagedar:

On December 20, 2012, the Commission approved Decision (D.)12-12-033, which required Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), Southern California Edison Company (SCE), San Diego Gas and Electric Company (SDG&E), PacifiCorp and California Pacific Electric Company (CalPeco), to hire a firm that will be responsible for proposing customer education activities for 2014 and 2015 related to the return of greenhouse gas (GHG) allowance revenue to utility customers.

Ordering Paragraph 12 of this Decision requires that the Commission's Energy Division Director approve the utilities' scope of work to select this firm, which I did in a letter dated March 11, 2013. The Decision also requires approval by the Energy Division Director before the utilities may hire a firm.

I have reviewed proposals submitted in response to the competitive solicitation, and I have reviewed the utilities' scoring of the proposals. I find that the utilities' scoring is reasonable, and I approve of the selection of TargetBase as the winner of the solicitation. I encourage PG&E to move forward with the necessary actions to hire TargetBase by April 1, 2013, as ordered in D.12-12-033.

Thank you for your team's efforts to work within aggressive time constraints. I look forward to ongoing collaboration as the consultant conducts its work.
