The **specific showing that PG&E will be required to provide in its application will be considered in a workshop** to be held no later than 90 days from the effective date of this decision. We expect this expedited application to be limited in scope, but we believe that an expedited application will be a more appropriate means to review the submitted data than an advice letter.” (Decision 12-12-030, p. 115, emphasis added)

“Pacific Gas and Electric Company must file an application within 30 days after the completion of its Maximum Allowable Operating Pressure validation and records search to present the results of those efforts and update its Implementation Plan authorized revenue requirements and related budgets, consistent with this decision.” (Decision 12-12-030, Ordering Paragraph 11)
