The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) today received a motion by the City of San Bruno calling for the recusal of Commissioners or postponement of the CPUC's May 7-8, 2013, Safety Symposium. Although the Symposium is a forward-looking event and issues related to the CPUC's ongoing PG&E pipeline cases would not be discussed, to eliminate any possible public concern over the fairness of the CPUC's process the CPUC has decided to postpone the Symposium to a future date.
