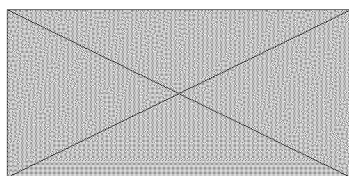
I suspect it is easier for almost everyone else, other than Michael Richard, to meet in San Francisco.
