
Dear Mr. Randolph:

Effective January 1, 2003, California Public Code (PUC) Section 2827(e)(1) requires that electric service providers notify the Commission prior to processing of a request for establishment of Net Energy Metering (NEM) service for solar or generator if the time to complete the application (including signed interconnection agreement and final inspection clearance from the governmental authority with jurisdiction) exceeds thirty (30) working days from the date electric service provider receives the customer's completed application.

In compliance with the PUC Section 2827, PG&E hereby submits the enclosed summary sheets list solar and interconnection projects that meet these criteria for the Fourth Quarter of 2012, from October 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012. To protect customer confidentiality, Project's ID number is used to identify projects. Also provided 1) the reason the interconnection has not yet been approved; 2) the expected completion date.

Unless directed otherwise, PG&E will continue to submit this notice in this format on a quarterly basis.
