




Federal: Rules and Regulations

- Tree-Line Contact initiated Northeast Black of 2003




Utilities

 - Tree Removal




Why do we trim trees

 - Required to maintain compliance year round
- Trees Look "Ugly"
 - DirectionTrimming\Pruning
 - ANSI A-300, Best
