Dear Ms. Vanko:

This letter responds to Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) April 5, 2013 electronic mail request for extension. PG&E requested an extension of time to comply with Decision (D.) 12-11-016, pursuant to Rule 16.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules).

The adopted schedule for the 2012 Renewables Portfolio Standard Solicitation requires PG&E and San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) to meet certain solicitation milestones by specific dates. The table below summarizes the scheduled milestones, the adopted dates, and PG&E's requested extension dates for PG&E's solicitation only.
