For the past two weeks the Building Manager's office at 455 Golden Gate Ave has been attempting to correct a significant failure of their access card reader system. This has affected their ability to process new cards as well as make changes to existing cards.

For staff with existing cards, your access to the building, elevator and 7th floor should be active during normal business hours of 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. <u>Please note that access cards for 505 Van Ness Ave and 455 Golden Gate Ave must be kept separated when attempting to make access as they each interfere with the other if in the same holder.</u>

Once the card reader system is functional, all cards will be set for 24/7 access, allowing for off-hour and weekend access.

For Bike Room access, please complete the attached form after reviewing the attached "Bike Room Policy." Please deliver the form to the Building Manager's Office in room 2600. While the card reader system is down, they will provide a list of personnel to building security for Bike Room access. After the card reader is functional, they will remotely program your card for access via the card. Please note that room access is "first-come, first-serve" and that the Bike Room at 505 Van Ness is available as an alternate location.

For staff moving to 455 Golden Gate Ave who have yet to receive a card, you will need

to be screened by security for entry into the building during normal business hours. Please coordinate with your Division Liaison for access to the 7th floor bathrooms.

Your patience during this period is appreciated. The 455GG Building Manager's Office is working diligently with DGS from Sacramento to fix the problems with the card reader system. As soon as they are fixed, we will send a notification and address all outstanding issues with distribution of cards and adjustments to access hours.
