DIGEST

Res E-4529: Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E) request for the Commission approve Confirmation for Resource Adequacy Capacity Products that PG&E executed with Calpine Energy Services, L.P. (Calpine)

Pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 311(e), this is the digest of the substantive differences between the proposed resolution of Energy Division (mailed on February 28, 2013), and the alternate proposed resolution of Commissioner Mark J. Ferron.

- The original resolution approves PG&E's Confirmation for Resource Adequacy Product which is an Agreement for Combined Heat and Power Resource Adequacy Capacity Product for 280.5 Megawatts of combined heat and power resource adequacy capacity associated with the Los Medanos Energy Center, LLC,.
- The Alternate Resolution of Michael R. Peevey rejects the Confirmation for Resource Adequacy Product and provides guidance to SCE for potential modifications to the Agreement which the Commission would approve in a subsequent Tier 1 Advice Letter filing and provides additional guidance to PG&E for Combined Heat and Power solicitations in the future.
- The Alternate Resolution of Mark J. Ferron rejects without prejudice the Confirmation for Resource Adequacy Product. SCE may seek approval of the contracts within the existing Resource Adequacy procurement framework, as long as the associated MWs do not count towards the QF/CHP program targets. The alternate resolution provides additional guidance to PG&E for Combined Heat and Power solicitations in the future.
