MOTION FOR PARTY STATUS OF FRIENDS OF THE EARTH

Friends of the Earth (FoE) hereby moves to become a party in the above-captioned proceeding under Rules 1.4(a)(4) and (b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

I. FOE'S INTEREST IN THIS PROCEEDING

FoE's interest in this proceeding is to advance the role of energy storage systems (ESS) in California's energy future so that ESS, combined with renewable energy can become the "baseload" replacement for both fossil fuels and nuclear power.

FoE is a U.S. internal revenue code § 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that has worked for over forty years to reduce the dangers from nuclear energy and fossil fuels and promote renewable energy and efficiency technologies. FoE has played an important role before this commission in numerous proceeding—most recently in the OII investigation of the now closed San Onofre nuclear reactors. We now seek to play an equally important role in this proceeding, which can establish ESS as the vital partner with renewable energy and efficiency to replace nuclear power and fossil fuel generated power in California.

Over 2,000 members of FoE live in the state of California. FoE therefore has a direct interest in this proceeding, which will determine whether these members can enjoy a truly clean

air and safe energy future. Furthermore, this proceeding will set the pace for the advance of storage nationally and as a nation-wide organization, FoE can help assure that California's leadership is followed across the country.

If FoE's motion is granted, we intend to be an active participant that will enrich the proceeding with the testimony and perspective of a leading environmental organization with no financial interest in the outcome. Our participation will not prejudice any party nor will it expand the scope of the proceeding. FoE's participation will be pertinent to the issues that are under consideration by the Commission in this docket and will not cause any delay in the proceeding.

II. THE FACTUAL AND LEGAL CONTENTATIONS THAT FOE INTENDS TO MAKE IN THIS PROCEEDING ARE PERTINENT TO THE ISSUES ALREADY PRESENTED

FoE holds that energy storage has the potential to transform how the California electric system is conceived, designed, and operated. We will contend that ESS can offer necessary services as California seeks to maximize the value of its generation and transmission investments and optimize the grid to avoid further investments in new fossil fuel-powered plants while integrating renewable power, and minimizing greenhouse gas emissions. FoE will contend that as a result of this proceeding the Commission should give the highest priority to an ESS-renewables-efficiency alternative to any proposed fossil fueled or nuclear fueled addition to the California power system. Only with such a firm policy will California be irrevocably embarked on the road to a 100% renewable, sustainable energy future.
