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Energy Division staff requests information from Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), regarding the contract, budget, and total expenditures to date by TargetBase in fulfillment of its responsibilities to propose customer outreach and education activities for 2014 and 2015 related to the return of GHG allowance revenue to utility customers. In the questions below, "scope of work" and "RFP" refer to the 2014/2015 GHG allowance revenue outreach and education RFP and associated scope of work approved by Energy Division in a letter to PG&E dated March 11, 2013. "Contract" refers to the agreement executed between PG&E and TargetBase, or other IOUs and TargetBase, which set the terms under which TargetBase is performing its work related to 2014/2015 GHG outreach and education.

Information Requested

1. Please provide a copy of the contract executed between PG&E and TargetBase (or between all IOUs and TargetBase if more than one IOU is a signatory to the contract).
2. Provide the total budget that TargetBase submitted in its RFP bid.

3. Indicate the total amount of expenditures paid to TargetBase to date under this contract, and indicate the amount and date of expected future expenditures in fulfillment of this contract.
4. Provide the total budget approved for TargetBase to complete its work in fulfillment of its contract. If this budget has no maximum and is not fixed, please indicate what expenditures are permitted and/or expected.
5. How much of the \$500,000 authorized in OP 13 of D.12-12-033 will remain after fulfilling the TargetBase contract?
