(4) Project managers be limited to three representatives, one line 17 representative each from Pacific Gas and Electric Company, line 18 Southern California Edison Company, and San Diego Gas and line 19 Electric Company.

CPUC specific language starts on page 135

In a very quick and dirty nutshell—New items are:

An Office of Ratepayer Advocate is created in the CPUC. They will create their own budget and work directly with Department of Finance.

We must do a Zero based budget over the next 18 months

LLNL per se was killed. Two of the programs – cybersecurity and grid integration lived on with \$30 some million total and some additional oversight

CPUC cannot independently create non-state entities except with shareholder funds

No contracts with NGOs that have a commissioner on board

Settlement monies cannot be spent without notifying Finance and then Join Legislative Budget

Committee (this would affect things like NRG settlement)

No Commissioners can sit on boards. CPUC created after Jan 1, 2015

This is still not passed by the two houses and is not yet signed. However, I think it predicts the future.
