On Wednesday, July 3, 2013 at approximately 2:20 p.m., DRA analyst Nika Rogers met with Marcelo Poirier, advisor to Commissioner Florio at Mr. Poirier's office at 505 Van Ness Avenue in San Francisco, CA. Ms. Rogers discussed and re-emphasized DRA's request contained in its joint motion filed on June 28, 2013.¹ In addition, Ms. Rogers and Mr. Poirier discussed the Track IV San Onofre Nuclear Power Station (SONGS) assumptions and power flow analysis studies undertaken by the CAISO, as well as the agenda for the upcoming July 15, 2013 joint CEC/CPUC/CAISO workshop on grid reliability and no SONGS.
