Without knowing what PG&E's latest cost calculations are -- and based on our admittedly limited understanding of the entire history of negotiations -- we thought about some questions in advance of our discussion. No doubt, there would be some follow-up depending on answers.

Since we do not know how PG&E is coming up with these different cost figures, here are some questions we may want to ask:

- 1) Are the costs given firm or subject to further adjustments and if so for what?
- 2) Since the system has been inspected and is relatively new, it should be up to PG&E standard, including services in conduits and all built and maintained per G.
- O. 166, shouldn't the transfer cost be the ITCC for the depreciated value minus the allowances plus some admin. costs?
- 3) Are the estimates based on the 50% discount option? Why not?
