The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) today released a Proposed Decision that would enable the White House Green Button Connect initiative to expand throughout most of California. If approved by the CPUC, the tariffing procedures would allow customers to authorize a third-party service provider to receive direct access to their energy data at no cost. Data would only be sent to third parties with customer consent and the process would be carefully overseen by the CPUC. The Proposed Decision would expand the existing Green Button Connect service at San Diego Gas & Electric to Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Southern California Edison.

Said CPUC President Michael R. Peevey, "This Proposed Decision is a key step in achieving California's energy efficiency and clean energy goals. Customers have a right to their energy consumption data. Tools like the Green Button empower customers to save energy and create opportunities for new energy services and products, while protecting privacy."
