**BASIS FOR PARTY STATUS**

TAS Energy is a technology company based in Houston, Texas that manufactures clean energy equipment, including a thermal energy storage chilling solution for gas turbines called “Generation Storage.” TAS Energy has deployed 592 MW of Generation Storage across 8 projects in both PJM and ERCOT.

TAS Energy has been actively engaged informally in this proceeding as a member of the transmission connected use case working group, an invited speaker at the joint workshop with Rulemaking 12-03-014 (Order Instituting Rulemaking to Integrate and Refine Procurement Policies and Consider Long-Term Procurement Plans) on September 7, 2012, and as a member

of the California Energy Storage Alliance. TAS Energy wishes to receive formal party status in this proceeding to better contribute in the proceeding as policy options are proposed.

**INTENDED PARTICIPATION AND INVESTED EFFORT**

TAS Energy is committed to continuing to invest time and resources in evaluation of proposed policy options and through submitting comments based upon experience with cost effective energy storage technology for gas turbines deployed and operating in markets outside of California. Specifically we commit to offer comments to the Assigned Commissioner's Ruling Proposing Storage Procurement Targets and Mechanisms and Noticing All-Party Meeting and other Motions, Rulings, and Proposed Decisions issued during the proceeding.

TAS Energy's participation in this proceeding will not prejudice any other party to this proceeding, delay the schedule, or expand the scope of the issues to be considered.
