Hi Richard,

Yes, we have occasionally tested for radon in the past but not on a regular basis. We have not tested for other naturally occurring radioactive constituents. The reason for the very limited testing is that we have no reason to believe these radioactive items are present to any significant extent in gas delivered to our customers.
