RE: Request for Extension of Time for Opening Comments on "Assigned Commissioner's Ruling (ACR) Regarding the Transfer of Responsibility for Collecting Solar Statistics from the California Solar Initiative to the Net Energy Metering Interconnection Process"

Dear Commissioner Peevey:

PG&E, on behalf of itself, Southern California Edison Company and San Diego Gas & Electric Company, respectfully requests that the deadline for opening comments on the ACR be extended from Friday, August 30 to Monday, September 9. This extension is necessary and reasonable for the following reasons:

1. The ACR was just issued last Thursday afternoon, August 22, and the utilities need more time to review the scope of its detailed requirements regarding compilation and collection of data from customers and the solar industry, and the transition from data collection under the CSI program to data collection as part of the utilities' interconnection process.
2. The ACR raises important cross-cutting issues regarding the impact of additional data collection on the solar industry and the interconnection process; the protection of customer privacy; and the costs of the data access and disclosure proposed by the ACR. These issues require careful review and responses by interested parties.

3. This week is a pre-holiday week, and the deadline set by the ACR for the opening comments is the day before the long holiday weekend, which may make it difficult for the utilities and interested parties to obtain internal review and sign-off of responses to the ACR from knowledgeable persons who may be on vacation.

For these reasons, PG&E, on behalf of itself, SCE and SDG&E, respectfully requests a nominal extension of the deadline for opening comments from Friday, August 30, to Monday, September 9. The current deadline for reply comments would be extended commensurately.

Because of the short time in which to obtain a ruling on this extension request, PG&E is serving the service list of R.12-11-005 simultaneously with sending this extension request, so that other parties to R.12-11-005 can provide their comments on the request directly to the Assigned Commissioner in parallel with this request.

Thank you for your consideration of this request.
