Brian Turner, 40, of Berkeley, has been appointed deputy executive director at the California Public Utilities Commission. Turner has been an assistant executive officer of federal climate policy at the California Air Resources Board since 2008. He was deputy director of Governor Brown's Washington, D.C. Office from 2008 to 2012 and a policy analyst at the International Council on Clean Transportation and the Bipartisan Policy Center from 2007 to 2008. Turner was a graduate student researcher and instructor at the University of California, Berkeley from 2004 to 2006 and a geographical information systems specialist at the Sonoma Land Trust from 2000 to 2003. Turner earned a Master of Science degree in energy and resources from the University of California, Berkeley and a Master of Public Policy degree from the University of California, Berkeley Goldman School of Public Policy. This position does not require Senate confirmation and the compensation is \$124,656. Turner is registered decline-to-state.
