PG&E Team:

Nothing is more important than the safety of the public and our employees. That simple idea is the foundation of our safety culture and must guide how we operate every day.

Yesterday, we fell short of our goal of zero injuries during the demolition of the former Kern Power Plant. Several members of the public, gathered outside a pre-established 1,000-foot perimeter, were struck by flying debris. One man was seriously injured and was airlifted to a Fresno hospital. Due to patient privacy laws, we do not have updated information on the individual's identity or condition.

I am deeply disappointed that this accident occurred. We will of course work closely with all investigating agencies and the third-party contractors who managed and carried out the demolition as they work to identify the cause of this accident. In the meantime, please keep the victim in your thoughts and prayers, and please keep safety foremost in your mind each and every day.
