I am notifying you of an incident that occurred today at approximately 11:40 am with a contract fixed wing aircraft that resulted in (2) fatalities while performing aerial patrolling for our Gas Operations. No PG&E employees were involved in this incident.

The plane crash occurred (6) miles southwest of Paradise, CA (near Chico)

which also sparked a vegetation fire. We are making internal & external notifications associated with this incident and will cooperate fully with the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) in the investigation of this incident.

We will be standing down on all aerial patrol activities for the next (2) days. Please contact me directly if you have any questions.
