**MOTION OF THE UTILITY REFORM NETWORK TO ACCEPT LATE-FILED
COMMENTS ON PROPOSED DECISION**

In accordance with Rule 11 of the Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure, The Utility Reform Network hereby submits this motion to accept late-filed comments on the proposed Decision Adopting Energy Storage Procurement Framework and Design Program (“PD”) issued September 3, 2013 by Administrative Law Judges (“ALJ”) Amy Yip-Kikugawa and Colette Kersten and Commissioner Carla Peterman’s office.

Rule 14.3 of the Commission’s Rules requires comments on proposed decisions to be filed within 20 days of the date of its service on parties. The due date for the comments on the PD was therefore September 23, 2013. TURN’s attorney, however, was ill and unable to file the comments yesterday.
