The communication occurred on Tuesday, September 3, 2013, at approximately 3:00 pm at the offices of the California Public Utilities Commission. Sidney Dietz, Director, Regulatory Relations, PG&E, initiated the communication

with Michael Colvin, Advisor to Commissioner Mark Ferron. Also present from PG&E were Janice Berman, Senior Director of Customer Energy Solutions Energy Efficiency Strategy, and Alfred Gaspari, Principal Product Manager, Energy Efficiency Financing.

Mr. Dietz stated that PG&E supports OBR and sees its potential to attract more customers to EE projects. Ms. Berman stated PG&E supports the PD's requirement for written consent when transferring loans. Mr. Gaspari stated that the PD should not require the IOUs to shut off participants for non-payment of bank loans. Ms. Berman stated that the program since it is funded by EE money, should fund EE projects only.
