At approximately 2018 hours on September 22, 2013, there was a third party dig-in of a 2" steel main, located at Redacted in San Bruno, that caused an unintentional release of gas. The third-party excavator, Granite Construction, were performing rail work when they struck the main. PG&E crews arrived at approximately 2140 hours and are currently working to shut-in the gas. There were no injuries or deaths. The damage is expected to be less than \$50,000. The Fire Department were on scene. Major Bay Area media (KTVU-2) was on scene and is therefore, a CPUC reportable incident.
