Just a quick note to tell you about a project I am proud of – bringing LTE internet to Navajo people. I am the board chairman of the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority, which, three years ago, launched a big telecommunications project, got an ARRA grant, and installed 600mi of fiber-optic cable across the reservation. This month and next we are launching a home internet service, and hope to serve 70% of the persons on the reservation.

I believe that a greater connection to the world will unleash the creativity of our young people, and am very excited about it. Now, if we can only get craigslist to treat us as a separate place!
