Brian – FYI and heads-up. It looks like we will be providing two filings instead of one on the re-certification of line 147. We are currently in the process of completing our pipeline centerline survey, which tells us exactly where the pipe is in the ground at what GPS location. It is something we agreed to complete by year end 2012 for all of our transmission system. Line 147 was surveyed in mid-September but three areas were skipped (1.37 miles out of 3,98 miles) because of tree canopies that didn't allow GPS recording. As a result, we have sent someone manually out to do it (using conventional techniques). We hope to file the following upon approval from the ALJ. I've been told that SED and the ALJ are being informed now. Bottom-line – all the material needed to be in the hands of the Commission to certify Line 147 will be turned over by Wednesday. Hope this doesn't complicate things too much.
