Update:

I have agreement from APS to videotape the subject workshop. The NRC has contacted our Project Management contractor for the SWUS GMC SSHAC (GeoPentech) and notified them that they may not be able to attend due to the budget. If they are unable to attend the NRC requested a videotape of the workshop. If the NRC does not attend, APS has agreed to split the cost of the videotaping. If the NRC does attend the workshop, PG&E will pay full cost for videotaping. PG&E will pay full cost for transcription of the videotapes.

APS has also agreed with inviting the public to the workshop. The communication plan for the public invitation is outlined in Blair's email (attached).
