**I. DESCRIPTION OF PARTY**

I am a residential solar user for over six years with a small backup battery to insure 4/7 availability.

**II. STATEMENT OF INTEREST IN THIS PROCEEDING**

I have a 7.4kWp system with a kWh backup to guard against power interruptions. My system cannot send power from my batteries to the grid, but the suggested changes to my net-metering arrangements would hamper my ability to send surplus energy from my panels to the grid when the grid needs all the help it can get. I have generated over 6,000 kWh of solar electricity since becoming operational in 008.

These experiences and ongoing activities will allow me to offer unique input on the various issues to be resolved in this rulemaking. In addition to filing comments, I contemplate additional appropriate participation as an active party in this proceeding.
