At approximately 3:43 am, PG&E was notified by San Jose Fire Department of a vehicle impact into a meter manifold at [Redacted] in San Jose, resulting in an unintentional release of gas. A PG&E Gas Service Representative (GSR) was on site at 4:05 am. By the time the GSR arrived, San Jose Fire Department had shut off gas service to the manifold. The manifold served an apartment complex and had 5 meters. There were no injuries, no fatalities, and no ignition of gas. Fire department and major media were observed on site.

This incident was reported to the CPUC due to major media being observed on site.
