**Subject:** CPUC Reportable Incident: San Bruno

PG&E reported a T&R crew was working at 175 Acacia Ave in San Bruno (XST San Felipe) struck and partially pulled off a 3/4 -inch steal Tee on a 2-inch steal main at approx. 0915 hrs with a backhoe, causing an unintentional release of gas. A second crew was dispatched at approx. 0915 hrs and arrived on site at approx. 0940 hrs. Crew is currently working with local engineering, an isolation plan relative to shutting in the effected main has been established. A 2-way shut in with the use of bolt-on control fittings will be utilized. Shut in time yet to be determined, but estimated time of shut-in is 1230 hours. There is a valid USA ticket. Post-Accident Testing was completed.

The FD has the street blocked off and about 8 customers are without gas service. The Peninsula OEC is activated for communications only and an elementary school that is located about a mile away is being evacuated.

There were no injuries. No media as of yet. This incident is being reported to the CPUC only due to operator judgment and evacuation of the elementary school.
