CONSIDERATION: As full consideration for satisfactory performance of the Work under this CWA by Contractor, PG&E's total obligation to Contractor shall not exceed the following amount. This amount is inclusive of all taxes incurred in the performance of the Work. Any change to this amount shall only be authorized in writing by a PG&E CWA Change Order, fully executed by both PG&E and Contractor.

TOTAL: Lump Sum Not to Exceed \$18,000.00

The following sections present our scope of work, schedule, and fees for completing the project.

SCOPE OF WORK

OBJECTIVE: To evaluate those PG&E systems in place on June 19, 2012 intended to provide safety oversight of demolition activities at the PG&E KPP facility, in Bakersfield, California and provide recommendations for improvements based on best industry practices.

Bureau Veritas will provide a certified safety professional experienced in assessing safety management systems (CSP, CPEA-Safety) from our San Ramon, California office to conduct a management systems assessment that focuses on PG&E's management systems affecting the safety oversight of demolition activities at the PG&E KPP facility, in Bakersfield, California that were in place on June 19, 2012.

We will perform this assessment using a combination of activities including:

- Reviews of key documents,
- Interviews with key program developers, process owners, and process participants,

- Conducting a physical inspection of the work site

To facilitate the assessment, Bureau Veritas will:

- Prepare a list of requested PG&E, CWC, and subcontractor documents to be reviewed.
- Prepare a list of key PG&E, CWC, and subcontractor personnel (by job function) to be interviewed.
- Visit the KPP site

Bureau Veritas will require administrative support from PG&E, CWC, and selected subcontractors to supply requested documents, identify the individuals fulfilling the job functions identified by Bureau Veritas to be interviewed, and to schedule the interviews.

Prior to the issuance of the draft report, Bureau Veritas will schedule a meeting with PG&E to discuss the preliminary observations and findings of the assessment. Subsequent to the review meeting, Bureau Veritas will provide a draft report to you within 15 working days from the acceptance of this proposal. You will be notified by e-mail if a draft report will not be distributed within that time period.

FEES

Bureau Veritas bases our cost estimate on up to 12 person-days including 1 on-site visit to the KPP. Bureau Veritas will provide the services described herein for an time and materials estimated fee of **\$18,000.00** that includes our professional service fees to complete all project-related work, report generation, and expenses. The estimated fee assumes that the scope of work can be completed without interruption. In the event that interruptions are experienced due to circumstances beyond our control, additional costs may be incurred.

SCHEDULE

We will schedule this work to proceed immediately upon authorization. Our services will be performed according to the Master Services Agreement (MSA # 4400005800, effective 2-2-12) established between BVNA and Pacific Gas and Electric.
