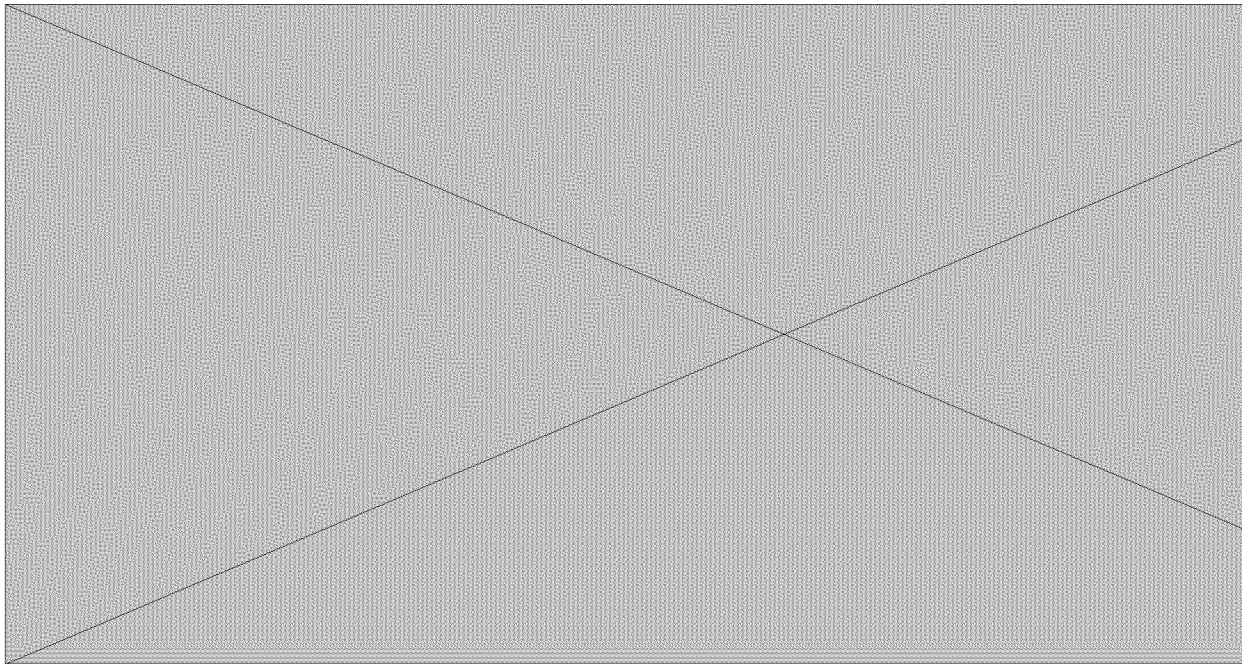

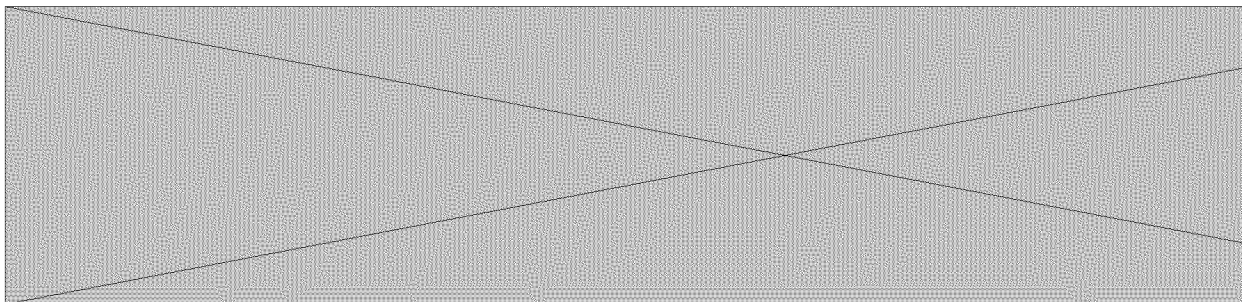
On November 15, 2013 PG&E submitted to the California Public Utilities Commission, Energy Division, a copy of the Amended 2012 PRELIMINARY ANNUAL 33% RPS COMPLIANCE REPORT OF PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (U 39 E) (PUBLIC VERSION) (the "Amended PG&E 2012 RPS Compliance Report"), in PDF format, originally submitted on August 1, 2013. The Amended PG&E 2012 RPS Compliance Report includes a spreadsheet summarizing and detailing PG&E's RPS compliance status and a narrative discussion of factors that may impact RPS compliance. Instructions at the bottom of this e-mail allow parties to access electronic or hard-copy versions of the Amended PG&E 2012 RPS Compliance Report.

PG&E is amending the report to remove particular confidentiality markings. Specifically, PG&E is un-redacting column J in Appendix A, on the tab entitled "(2011) 36 Month Retirement" in the Excel file. Column J is located on pages 19 through 70 in the PDF file.

In addition, PG&E has recently discovered and corrected in this amended version of the RPS Compliance Report minor errors in column AJ (Contract Capacity) of the "Procurement Detail" Tab. These values have no impact on PG&E's RPS compliance position reported in its RPS Compliance Report. Rather, the values are provided as supplemental information in the "Procurement Detail" Tab. In order for a reader to easily identify the corrected records, PG&E has listed the revised values and their location in the "Procurement Detail" Tab in the table below.



With respect to four of these contracts (rows 1 through 4 in the table above), the errors occurred because PG&E inadvertently switched the supplemental information for these contracts. Therefore, column AE (Facility Location, City) and AG (Contract Execution Date) must also be corrected. The correct values for these records are listed in the table below.



The Amended PG&E 2012 RPS Compliance Report exceeds 50 pages, and it will be posted on November 15, 2013 on PG&E's website in a readable, downloadable, printable, and searchable format. Pursuant to Commission Rules 1.9(d)(1) and (3), PG&E is serving this Notice of Availability on interested parties in lieu of the electronic file of the Amended PG&E 2012 RPS Compliance Report.
