Subject: PG&E Received a Threat Notification from CHP

Liza,

I wanted to share this with you since it relates to a notice PG&E received from the California Highway Patrol related to threats to aerial patrols and other maintenance work.

Yesterday PG&E received a call from the CHP notifying us of a landowner's threat to shoot at the next aircraft doing a low-altitude patrol in the Eastern Sierra Foothills area south of the city of Shingletown. The location of the complaint was identified as being just off of Wilson Hill Road near Manton City, California. The attached maps show the area of the threat. While there are no gas transmission pipelines that are regularly patrolled in the area, in order to protect our aviation people and assets, we have identified a parameter in this area in which no low-altitude flying should take place. We have notified all PG&E flight personnel and are taking appropriate steps to address this.
