Dear Mr. Clanon:

Pursuant to Rule 16.6 of the California Public Utilities Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, for the reasons set forth below, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) respectfully requests, on behalf of Southern California Edison Company (SCE), and San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) (collectively, the Utilities), an extension of time to comply with the December 31, 2013 deadline to file a Plug-in Electric Vehicle (PEV) Load Research Report.

The December 31, 2013 deadline for filing the report research was established in Decision (D.) 13-06-04 Phase 3 Decision Authorizing Short-term Extension of Limited Provisions Regarding Electric Tariffs 15 and 16 issued July 3, 2013, in Rulemaking 09-08-009.

According to Ordering Paragraph 3 of D. 13-06-04, the Energy Division was directed to revise the load research methodology and provide the Utilities. The Utility and Commission staff have made good progress to developing the revised methodology for the PEV Load Research Reports. The Utilities have been assisting the Energy Division in understanding the utilities' systems to support development of the new methodology. The Energy Division and the utilities have had several productive meetings and are very close to finalizing the revised scope for the report. However, as of this date, the Energy Division is finalizing the cost tracking methodology and has yet to provide guidance to the Utilities on the cost tracking portion of the report. More time is needed to complete this step and without this guidance, the Utilities will be unable to complete the report.

Accordingly, the Utilities ~~truly~~ request that the ~~December 2013~~ deadline to file a joint load research report ~~be extended~~ January 31, 2014.

We greatly appreciate your prompt consideration of this matter. Counsel for SCE and SDG&E have authorized PG&E to submit this request on their behalf.
