Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), on behalf of itself, Southern California Edison Company (SCE), and San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E), also requests an extension of time to address the Assigned Commissioner's Ruling Regarding the Establishment of a Net Energy Metering Transition Period (ACR) issued on November 27, 2013. That Ruling asked for Opening Comments to be filed by this Friday, December 6, with Replies due December 16. As the Commission is aware, there are very complex issues raised by the legislative mandate to develop a transitional NEM grandfathering period.

We are aware and sensitive to the fact that the legislature has directed the CPUC to address NEM Transition by March 31, 2014, and suggest a proposal that will allow the CPUC to meet that schedule, but also allow time for a more thorough and thoughtful analysis. **We support the recent request from Vote Solar for an extension to December 13th for comments and December 23rd for reply comments.** This would allow parties to more thoughtfully address the questions raised in the Ruling. **We also suggest that any parties who wish to provide analysis or data or other materials supporting their recommendations, such as spreadsheets or other data with payback calculation information, could provide that support and analysis at the same time as their reply comments on December 23rd.**

PG&E, SCE and SDG&E respectfully request that the Commission adopt a schedule that incorporates the proposals above.

Dear ALJ MacDonald,

On Wednesday, November 27, the Commission issued the Assigned Commissioner's Ruling Regarding the Establishment of a Net Energy Metering (NEM) Transition Period (ACR) in Rulemaking

(R.) 12-11-005. It has come to my attention that the ACR is available on the docket card, but it has not yet been served on the proceeding service list. The ACR required parties to submit opening comments by this Friday, December 6 and reply comments by Monday, December 16.

The NEM transition period is a matter of great importance. While The Vote Solar Initiative commends the Assigned Commissioner for moving quickly to seek comment on the topic, it is important to ensure adequate time for thoughtful responses from all parties who wish to comment. To that end we respectfully request an extension of one week on the comment period laid out in the ACR. If Vote Solar's request is granted, opening comments will be due on Friday, December 13 and reply comments will be due on Monday, December 23.
