On December 18th, 2013 CPUC Energy Division staff, in collaboration with the CAISO and CEC, hosted a workshop to solicit feedback on planning assumptions, scenarios, and renewable resource portfolios to be used in the CPUC 2014-2015 long term procurement plan proceeding and provided to the ISO for use in their 2014-2015 transmission planning process.

The Scenario Tool, Scenario Matrix, Summary of RPS Portfolios, Planning Assumptions and Scenarios document, and slides from the December 18<sup>th</sup> Workshop are now available online at:

Please note that the "Summary of RPS Portfolios in Excel" has been updated to include all six proposed RPS portfolios. The names of each portfolio have also been changed to better reflect the purpose of a portfolio version. The "Planning Assumptions and Scenarios Word Document" has been updated to reflect this RPS portfolio update in section 4.2.6, section 6, and section 7 (Appendix). Other than by name, the RPS portfolios have not changed from what was presented in the Dec 18th, 2013 Workshop. The "Scenario Tool in Excel v1" does not include Net Qualifying Capacity ("NQC") values for the RPS portfolios beyond 2024. This shortcoming will be fixed when the "NQC" values for the RPS portfolios beyond 2024 analysis is finished.
