PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

SUBJECT: CONSOLIDATED GAS RATE CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2014

San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) hereby submits, for California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) approval, the following changes to its gas tariffs, shown in Attachment B.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this filing is to consolidate several previously filed advice letters and Commission decisions that reflect gas rate changes. This results in \$8.3 million decrease, with Franchise Fees and Uncollectibles (FF&U) in SDG&E's gas transportation (non-commodity) revenue requirement for core customers as well as a \$4.7 million decrease for noncore customers, resulting in a total net decrease of \$13.0 million (4.0%), with FF&U, effective January 1, 2014, as reflected in Attachment A. This decrease represents the gas rate adjustments requested by compliance Advice Letters (AL) 2228-G and 2237-G; Decisions (D.) 09-11-006 and D.13-05-010.

In addition, this filing reflects increased gas transportation costs allocated from Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) to SDG&E as reflected in SoCalGas' consolidated rate update AL 4586, dated December 27, 2013.

DISCUSSION

2011 Energy Efficiency Incentive Awards

Pursuant to D.12-12-032, SDG&E filed AL 2228-G¹ on September 26, 2013, requesting its program year 2011 Energy Efficiency (EE) incentive awards. Pursuant to Resolution G-3491, SDG&E was authorized an award of \$0.781 million, without FF&U, effective January 1, 2014. This results in the Rewards and Penalties Balancing Account (RPBA) amortization of \$0.564 million, without FF&U.
