The answer to your question about additional curtailments in Redwood City and San Carlos is that those are not likely, even with colder weather.

Per Mel, they are not facing any additional curtailments under the way we are operating now. Mel's team did a good job preserving service to San Carlos and

Redwood City.

But again the bigger issue is that operating Line 147 as a distribution feeder main at 125 psig increases operating risk on the entire Peninsula.
