As you likely know from Willard Lam, the work to evaluate the Oakland distribution pipe failure is continuing.

PG&E engineers and specialists from Exponent Engineering are currently conducting tests on the removed pipe and investigating other factors that may have contributed to the leak and subsequent ignition. They will work through the weekend and will continue until we have a complete report. Jane Yura will provide another update to you Monday afternoon with the facts we have by that time.

The City of Oakland, through Vice Mayor Larry Reid, has scheduled a meeting with community members on Monday, December 16 at 6:00 p.m. to discuss resident concerns about the incident, and we will have representatives there to discuss what we know. The information we provide at the Oakland meeting will be consistent with the information you receive from Jane Yura earlier in the day.
