I just wanted to get back to you, as I said I would at the meeting on Monday, with the 2012 PG&E DR data. This is in the same format as was done for SCE and SDG&E in the ED 2012 report. As you can see, the numbers are reasonably close between what we forecast and delivered. There is also room for improvement and we are taking steps to do that too.

Thanks for meeting with us and being willing to share your current ideas on DR. We appreciated the opportunity.

You had indicated that you'd be open to more discussion and we think that could be very

helpful. Would it be useful for you to meet again in early December (e.g. week of December 9<sup>th</sup>) and we could provide more in-depth information for you on an area you'd like to hear more about?

This could include – why current DR programs are normally dispatched after gas turbines, how demand side resources can help with the “Duck curve”, or our experience with bidding DR into the CAISO markets and what we've learned that could allow better DR integration with the CAISO. These are just some ideas. If you have other topics we can provide you information on - just let us know.
