DUBLIN, Calif. —

An oven exploded inside the kitchen at a [Redacted] Tuesday, critically injuring one person and injuring 10 others, authorities said.

According to the Alameda County Fire Department, the explosion took place at around 11:42 a.m. at the massive facility that houses [Redacted]

Alameda County Fire spokeswoman Aisha Knowles said the oven caught fire and then exploded.

Several emergency units were set to the scene to treat the injured. Four of the injured were taken to local hospitals while seven others were being treated in the jail's infirmary.

The cause of the explosion is under investigation, Knowles said.
