Re: Joint Request of the California Solar Initiative Program Administrators for Extension of Time in Accordance with Rule 16.6 to File the California Solar Initiative Semi-Annual Expense Reports

Dear Mr. Clanon,

In accordance with Rule 16.6 of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), on behalf of the Program Administrators (PAs) of the California Solar Initiative (CSI) Program, respectfully submits this request seeking approval of a time extension for submittal of the 2014 California Solar Initiative Semi-Annual PA Expense Reports (Reports) by each of the PAs. The CSI PAs are Southern California Edison Company, PG&E, and the California Center for Sustainable Energy in the service territory of San Diego Gas & Electric Company.

The Commission addressed the details of the Report in D.07-05-047, *Opinion Establishing Process for Approval of Interim Marketing Plans for the California Solar Initiative*, issued on May 29, 2007. The Commission also established the due dates of the Report to be on January 15 and July 15 of each year. Subsequently, the Commission's Energy Division requested to include in these Reports the yearly totals for all program elements that make up the CSI Program, including the CSI-Thermal Program, the Multifamily Affordable Solar Housing Program, the virtual net energy metering billing development, the Research, Development and Demonstration program, and any incidental expenses associated with the administration of the Single-Family Affordable Solar Housing Program.

The CSI PAs respectfully request a sixteen-day extension of time for submitting the 2014 Reports, originally due on January 15, 2014 and July 15, 2014. The requested new due dates are January 31 and July 31, 2014. Additional time is necessary to gather all the accounting data requested by the Commission's Energy Division, much of which is not available until the second week of the month.
