Subject: Follow up meeting on Advice Letter Transparency Initiative - Analyses Requested

Good Morning Redacted —

I hope your day is starting off well!

It has been eight days since our kick off meeting (held 1/21).

Can you assist in scheduling a follow up meeting? We should target 20 days out from today and 90 minutes in length if possible.

Additionally, I would like to request a written analysis, on Company letterhead, of what each individual IOU (PG&E, SDG&E, SCE, and SoCalGas) found during their meeting with their IT, web, and legal teams. Specifically, the scope of the analysis will address:

- The Design and Implementation of enhanced search capabilities to the websites of PG&E, SDG&E, SCE, and SoCalGas (e.g. Keyword search, Google Search)
- Enhancing 'Real-Time' consumer/stakeholder awareness of emerging regulatory issues (ex. enhanced access to G.O. 96-B Service Lists)

- Initiating real-time posting of Advice Letter Protests, Protest Replies, Comments, and Responses on the IOU websites
- The need for modification of G.O. 96-B Rules to expand regulation of IOU websites to comply with the goals of the Advice Letter Transparency Initiatives
- Ability to meet Initiative goals by June 30, 2014

The results of your analyses will be presented to the Energy Division Director in a joint meeting with representatives from Energy Division management and Legal.
