Dear Mr. Randolph:

In accordance with General Order 96-B, Section 5.3, Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") hereby withdraws the above-referenced advice letters without prejudice.

On July 7, 2003, PG&E submitted Advice 2399-E to request approval of its Demand Response Programs Demand Reserves Partnership (DRP) Program Implementation Plan. On May 10, 2004, PG&E submitted Advice 2505-E to request approval of a supplement to its DBP Implementation Plan and related documents. These advice letters are still pending Energy Division approval; however, the requests are now outdated and no longer relevant. Therefore, PG&E respectfully withdraws Advice Letters 2399-E and 2505-E.
