MARIN CLEAN ENERGY**

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Please be advised that on December 5, 2013 the Marin Energy Authority ("MEA") adopted the name "Marin Clean Energy" ("MCE") for its community choice aggregation ("CCA") program. For purposes of clarity, the Marin Energy Authority is a not-for-profit, public agency formed by the County of Marin and seven other cities and towns that administers Marin Clean Energy. Marin Clean Energy is a CCA program created by the Marin Energy Authority to purchase cleaner, renewable energy, with the main goal of stabilizing costs and reducing greenhouse gas emissions that cause climate change.¹ Going forward, MCE will be the named entity submitting filings to the Commission on behalf of itself and MEA.
